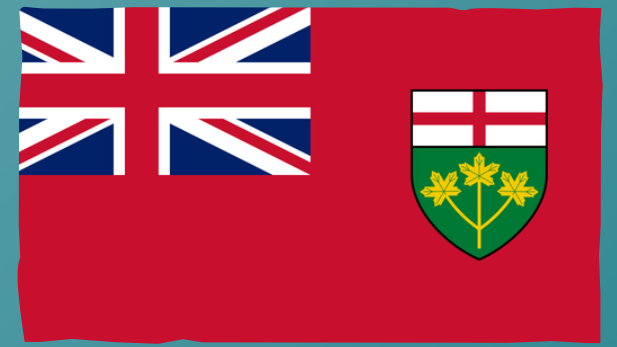

He holds degrees in Microbiology (BSc), Biophysics (MSc), and Psychology (MA), and earned his PhD in Cancer Biology (Molecular and Cellular Biophysics) from SUNY Buffalo.
